

## Conflict-Free Minerals Declaration

We hereby declare that, with respect to conflict minerals that may be contained in our products, including Tin (Sn), Tantalum (Ta), Tungsten (W), and Gold (Au), our company is committed to responsible sourcing practices and to avoiding the direct or indirect use of minerals sourced from conflict-affected areas that may contribute to armed groups, human rights violations, or illegal trade.

We require our suppliers to avoid the use of non-compliant minerals originating from the Democratic Republic of the Congo and its adjoining countries, or other conflict-affected and high-risk areas, in the raw materials, components, and products supplied to our company. Suppliers are expected to cooperate with necessary conflict minerals surveys and to provide relevant declarations or supporting documents upon request.

Our company does not directly purchase ores or smelted raw materials. The metallic materials and components used in our products are mainly sourced through upstream suppliers. We will continue to request supplier cooperation in conflict minerals due diligence according to customer requirements and supply chain management needs, and we will give priority to sources that comply with responsible minerals sourcing requirements.

If any supplied material is confirmed to be inconsistent with conflict-free minerals requirements, we will request the supplier to provide corrective actions. When necessary, we may take appropriate measures such as restricting procurement, evaluating alternative materials, or changing the supply source in order to reduce supply chain risk.

Our company will continue to monitor conflict minerals-related requirements and cooperate with customers and applicable regulations to promote responsible sourcing management within the supply chain.
